True Humility and Talents: Some people think that humility is a matter of taking yourself to be small, unworthy, not up for much. But, in the Gospel parable, the servant who thinks he is too little to do much with his talent is dismissed as wicked and useless, and his talent is taken away from him. The Lord doesn't praise him for his humility. So what is humility? It is the opposite of pride, but what is pride? Pride isn't thinking that there is some excellence, some talent, in you, when there really is. Rather, pride is a failure to recognize that talent as given by the Lord. Our talents are not a function of what we are and can do. Every excellence in us is a gift of the Lord's.

WORLD DAY OF THE POOR

Pope Francis has declared **Sunday**, **November 19th**, **2017** to be the first **World Day of the Poor**. On this day we are called to love and share with the poorest amongst us, and bear witness to Jesus' preferential love for the poor. Bless our communities, loving Mary, fill our hearts with compassion, help us to shelter the stranger, and share the goodness of God's consoling love with all our neighbours.

ST. BRIGID'S CHURCH RENOVATIONS

We would like to take this opportunity to advise our Parishioners and members of the community that our church needs an urgent intervention that requires two minor variances to the church property. They are: **A)** the old garage, which is in a very poor and dangerous condition. **B)** the old addition of the house which is slowly separating from the building, due to the lack of a proper foundation.

- **A. Garage Benefits:** For the church, the parishioners and the community at large: **1.** The clergy reserved parking spaces, for at least 5 cars, will be eliminated to give more space for community attendance to our services. **2.** Will reduce parking on the surrounding streets, which always creates traffic congestion, especially during the church celebrations and the dropping off and picking up of the students of the St. Brigid's Elementary School. On several occasions, Earl Beatty Public School also uses our parking lot. **3.** This will respect the street parking permits of the neighbours since there is more availability at the church parking lot. **4.** This will eliminate possible liabilities due to the deterioration of the above mentioned variances. **5.** This will give our church the possibility to continue with the preparation for our centennial celebration in 2020.
- **B.** The Benefits to the Addition: 1. This will allow the church to have permanent storage of our records, which is urgently required and needed. 2. This will give us the opportunity to have a room for our growing catechesis programs and for meetings. This room is currently the room used for filing cabinets.


