

EPIPHANY OF THE LORD / B

Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord. "The Lord and ruler is coming; kingship is His, and government and power." With these words the Church proclaims that today's Solemnity brings to a perfect fulfillment all the purposes of Advent. Epiphany, therefore, marks the liturgical zenith of the Advent-Christmas season. The young Messiah is revealed as the light of the nations. Yet, as the antiphon for the Magnificat at Second Vespers reminds us, three mysteries are encompassed in this solemnity: the adoration of the Christ Child by the Magi, the Baptism of Christ and the wedding feast at Cana.

FEAST OF THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

On January 8th, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. This brings to an end the Season of Christmas. The Church recalls our Lord's second manifestation (or "epiphany") which occurred on the occasion of His baptism in the Jordan. Jesus descended into the River to sanctify its waters and to give them the power to beget sons and daughters of God.
