

SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME / B

The prayers used in today's liturgy highlight the need for peace. The Collect asks God to "show us the way to peace in the world" and may God's truth "reflect peace to those who believe in your love." The Prayer After Communion asks that the Lord "make us one in peace and love." The First Reading is about the call of Samuel. The key moment is when Samuel learns to open himself up to God's message: "Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening." The Gospel is about another call, the call of the Apostles. Jesus challenges the two disciples with the question: "What are you looking for?" Which poses the question: What are we looking for in our world today? If we are looking for peace, are we listening to what the Lord is telling us about the Spirit of peace dwelling within us?

WORLD DAY OF MIGRANTS AND REFUGEES

The theme announced by His Holiness Pope Francis for the 2018 World Day of Migrants and Refugees is *"Welcoming, Protecting, Promoting and Integrating Migrants and Refugees"*. In his message, Pope Francis reminds us that "every stranger who knocks at our door is an opportunity for an encounter with Jesus Christ, who identifies with the welcomed and rejected strangers of every age..."

A special Mass commemorating the 104th World Day of Migrants and Refugees will be celebrated today, Sunday, January 14th at 1:00 pm at the Good Shepherd Chaldean Catholic Cathedral (2 High Meadow Place in North York). Bishop Wayne Kirkpatrick will be the homilist for this Liturgy. A reception will follow with a number of dignitaries in attendance. All are welcome to attend!

ST. BRIGID'S CENTENNIAL CHOIR REHEARSAL DATES: JANUARY 13th & 20th

St. Brigid's Centennial Choir is a community choir made up of parish members of all different types of musical ability. Our main focus is to assist and encourage the congregation in the offering of song as prayer using the core hymns of Catholic tradition. We rehearse twice monthly on the second and third Saturday's of the month and sing at the 11:00 am Mass on the third Sunday of the month. Joining in rehearsal is an important part of choir participation but with people's busy lives, it is understandable that this is not always possible. Resources are provided to choir members so that they can practice at home. As the choir becomes more established, we will begin to sing at major feast day Masses culminating with the St. Brigid's Parish centennial celebrations in 2020.
