

THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME / B

Today we begin a continuous reading of Mark's Gospel that will carry us through this segment of the liturgical season of Ordinary Time. The Gospel of Mark does not begin with a narrative about Jesus' birth. Instead Mark begins by reporting on the preaching of John the Baptist. John is described as the voice in the wilderness sent to prepare the way of the Lord. Immediately after describing the work of John the Baptist, Mark reports on Jesus' baptism and His temptation in the desert. Jesus' public ministry begins after the arrest of John the Baptist. Mark wants his readers to understand the important connection between the end of the ministry of John the Baptist and the beginning of Jesus' own ministry.

POPE FRANCIS IN CHILE

On his first full day in Chile (January 16th), Pope Francis told Catholics that the Beatitudes are not a simple piece of advice from someone who purports to know everything, instead, they are a source of hope which inspires people to leave their comfort zone and follow the path given by Jesus. "The Beatitudes are not the fruit of a hypercritical attitude or the 'cheap words' of those who think they know it all, yet are unwilling to commit themselves to anything or anyone." The Pope continued saying, "People with this attitude prevent any chance of generating processes of change and reconstruction in our communities and in our lives."


