FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME / B

Today's Gospel continues our reading from Mark and describes what some believe was likely to have been a typical day in Jesus' ministry. Jesus and the disciples that chose to follow Him arrive at Capernaum, a small village on the Sea of Galilee. Jesus teaches in the synagogue on the Sabbath. Mark reports that the people respond to Jesus' teaching with astonishment, noting Jesus' authority and contrasting it with the scribes. After Jesus' preaching, an even more astonishing event happened, a man possessed with an unclean spirit calls out to Jesus. Throughout Mark's Gospel, the spirits and demons seem to know Jesus, and are often fearful of Him. They seem to understand Jesus' identity better than His disciples. Jesus orders the spirit to be quiet and drives the unclean spirit out of the man. Jesus' ability to heal those possessed by demons is an indication of His power over evil.

THE HOLY FATHER'S INTENTIONS FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY 2018

The month of February is dedicated to the Holy Family. This year the first thirteen days of February fall during the liturgical season known as Ordinary Time which is represented by the liturgical color green. Green, the symbol of hope, is the color of the sprouting seed and arouses in the faithful the hope of reaping the eternal harvest of heaven, especially the hope of a glorious resurrection. The remaining days of February are the beginning of Lent. The liturgical colour changes to purple — a symbol of penance, mortification and the sorrow of a contrite heart.

ST. BRIGID'S CENTENNIAL CHOIR

St. Brigid's Centennial Choir is a community choir made up of parish members of all different types of musical ability. Our main focus is to assist and encourage the congregation in the offering of song as prayer using the core hymns of Catholic tradition. We rehearse twice monthly on the second and third Saturday's of the month and sing at the 11:00 am Mass on the third Sunday of the month. Joining in rehearsal is an important part of choir participation but with people's busy lives, it is understandable that this is not always possible. Resources are provided to choir members so that they can practice at home. As the choir becomes more established, we will begin to sing at major feast day Masses culminating with the St. Brigid's Parish centennial celebrations in 2020.


