

FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER / B

Today's Gospel reading is taken from middle of the Last Supper discourse. Jesus speaks about his relationship to his disciples. In his metaphor of the vine and the branches, Jesus is referencing the Hebrew Scriptures. In the Hebrew Scriptures, Israel is the vineyard, and Yahweh himself tends the vineyard. One of the primary themes of John's Gospel is to show Jesus to be the fulfillment of God's promises to Israel. In this passage, Jesus teaches his disciples that his relationship with them will not end after his death; he will remain with them always. This unity between Jesus and his disciples is the basis for their ability to continue to do the work that he began. Similarly, Jesus' presence with us through the Gift of the Holy Spirit enables us to continue the work of love and reconciliation that he began. Jesus also teaches his disciples about the importance of the words he has taught to them. Just as Jesus will remain in the disciples, so too will his words.

ST. CATHERINE OF SIENA

"We've had enough exhortations to be silent. Cry out with a thousand tongues. I see the world is rotten because of silence."

In today's political and social climate there is a loud and growing demand for change. Today, more than ever, we see the importance of standing up for change. Let us continue, just as St. Catherine of Siena did, to lend our voices and prayers in order to create change. "Christians are not meant to be lukewarm (Revelation 3:15 - 16). Rather, we are to be like Christ, and set the world on fire (Luke 12:49). We should not be afraid to go to God in prayer, and to witness to the faith in public."

SHARELIFE: LIVING THE GOSPEL BY HELPING NEWCOMERS TO CANADA

Angie moved to Canada to marry a man she met online. He was not who he presented himself to be. As a result, Angie endured emotional and physical abuse. While he was at work, she started attending language classes at **Catholic Crosscultural Services**. The staff at CCS connected her with a settlement worker in the women's program where she received the support she needed to exit her violent relationship and live independently and free from all forms of abuse. Angie is one of over 3,000 clients helped annually by CCS programs funded by ShareLife. The third and final ShareLife collection will take place on May 26th and 27th.
