

SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: C

This Sunday we begin the liturgical season of Ordinary Time. Today's Gospel reading describes the beginning of Jesus' ministry and his first miracle. To situate today's reading within the context of John's Gospel, we note that John's report of this event follows Jesus' call of his first disciples. John tells us that Jesus and his disciples were invited to this wedding at Cana, as was Jesus' mother, Mary. In the Church's liturgical history, the wedding feast of Cana is closely associated with the Baptism of the Lord and the adoration of the infant Jesus by the Wise Men. The sign Jesus performs at the wedding feast is celebrated as an epiphany or a manifestation of Jesus' divinity.
