Jane arrived in Toronto, not knowing the language, what to do, or who could help. Fortunately, she met an Arabic speaker who told her about Catholic Crosscultural Services (CCS).

CCS helped her to navigate the immigration process and access the resources she needed. Jane says, "CCS saved my life. Today I have money of my own, an apartment, and my children are finally safe and happy."
