

ST. BRIGID'S CHURCH WILL RECEIVE THE 2019 GREENING SACRED SPACE AWARD

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 8 - PASTORAL ASSEMBLY

For the last two years, St. Brigid's Church has been part of a case study conducted by The Archdiocese of Toronto Property Department and Faith & the Common Good (FCG), a national environmental, not for profit organization, who piloted an energy benchmarking program in Toronto to improve faith building energy. We were pleased to see that our hydro consumption decreased by 7% in 2017 (versus 2016); we attribute this to the fact that we did an LED lighting retrofit in our Church Hall and Sanctuary in 2017. Through our efforts we not only were the bench mark for other Parishes in the City, but we are also the winners of the 2019 Greening Sacred Space Award; this is truly an honour and we are very pleased to receive it.

The award will be presented to us at our Pastoral Assembly on Sunday, September 8th.
