

EDUCATE, REFLECT, AND ACT! PREPARING FOR A FEDERAL ELECTION

There will be a federal election held on **Monday**, **October 21**, **2019**. All eligible voters have a duty to cast a ballot. To help us reflect on important issues through the lens of our faith, the Archdiocese of Toronto has created a series of short one page resources on a variety of issues. These are non-partisan resources – they don't tell us which party to vote for, rather they help us view these issues through the lens of our Catholic faith, an important consideration as we discern who we will vote for on election day. On **Thursday, October 3rd**, The Archdiocese will host its first ever election debate at the John Bassett Theatre at the Metro Toronto Convention Centre. Cardinal Thomas Collins will start and end the evening with a personal reflection and prayer. The event will be moderated by Don Newman, an award winning political journalist.
