

Ma poteva indicare anche la venuta della divinità, che esce dal suo nascondimento per manifestarsi con potenza, o che viene celebrata presente nel culto.I cristiani adottarono la parola Avvento per esprimere la loro relazione con Gesù Cristo: Gesù è il Re, entrato in questa povera "provincia" denominata terra per rendere visita a tutti; alla festa del suo avvento fa partecipare quanti credono in Lui.
