# AROUND THE ARCHDIOCESE

On December 18, Pope Francis appointed **Bishop Wayne Kirkpatrick** as the new bishop of the Diocese of Antigonish, which is celebrating its 175th anniversary this year. His Excellency will be formally installed as the 10th Bishop of Antigonish in early 2020. Born in St. Catharines, Bishop Kirkpatrick has served the Archdiocese of Toronto faithfully since his appointment as an auxiliary bishop in 2012. "I am humbled by the trust placed in me by the Holy Father to serve the faithful of the Diocese of Antigonish," said Bishop Kirkpatrick. "I ask for your prayers and be assured of mine as I prepare for this new chapter of ministry." Cardinal Thomas Collins, Archbishop of Toronto, expressed his gratitude for Bishop Kirkpatrick's many contributions and pastoral outreach.
