

MESSAGE FOR LENT 2025

His Eminence Frank Cardinal Leo Metropolitan Archbishop of Toronto



As Pilgrims of Hope, our traditional Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving help to orient our thoughts, words and deeds toward God, His Kingdom and in steadfast

hope. Prayer is especially important, insofar as "hope is expressed and nurtured in prayer, especially in the Our Father, the summary of everything that hope leads us to desire" (CCC 1820). Fasting "takes up the hopes that inspire [our] activities and purifies them so as to order them to the Kingdom of heaven" (CCC 1818). And finally, Almsgiving, when done with compassion and in solidarity with those who suffer, especially the sick, the poor, the marginalized, and the oppressed, are concrete expressions of hope (cf. Spes non Confundit, 7-15). Have you given some thought to how you will embody these three practices in your Lenten journey this year?




"Come pellegrini della speranza, le nostre tradizionali pratiche quaresimali di preghiera, digiuno ed elemosina aiutano a orientare i nostri
