BEATIFICATION OF A YOUNG ITALIAN TECH WIZ

Carlo Acutis, an Italian teenager who used his computer programming skills to spread devotion to the Eucharist, was beatified on Saturday, October 10th, 2020. Before his death from leukemia in 2006, Acutis was an average teen with an above-average knack for computers. He put that knowledge to use by creating an online database of eucharistic miracles around the world. As a teenager, Carlo was diagnosed with leukemia. He offered his sufferings for Pope Benedict XVI and for the Church, saying, "I offer all the suffering I will have to suffer for the Lord, for the Pope, and the Church." Carlo died on October 12, 2006, and was buried in Assisi, at his request, because of his love for St. Francis of Assisi.
