## ANNOUNCEMENT FROM THE CANADIAN CONFERENCE OF CATHOLIC BISHOPS Healing & Reconciliation

On Tuesday, June 29th, the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops announced that the delegation to the Holy See is to foster meaningful dialogue and healing with Indigenous Peoples and the Holy Father will take place December 17th to the 20th, 2021. An excerpt of the statement reads as follows: "Pope Francis is deeply committed to hearing directly from Indigenous Peoples, expressing his heartfelt closeness, addressing the impact of colonization and the role of the Church in the residential school system, in the hopes of responding to the suffering of Indigenous Peoples and the ongoing effects of intergenerational trauma. The Bishops of Canada are deeply appreciative of the Holy Father's spirit of openness in generously extending an invitation for personal encounters with each of the three distinct groups of delegates – First Nations, Métis and Inuit – as well as a final audience with all delegates together on 20 December 2021." O God, we praise and thank you for the blessings of life in Canada, from your natural bounty and from the work of human hands.

We ask you to open our ears to the truths about our collective history shared with the Truth and Reconciliation Commission by survivors of residential schools.

We ask you to open our minds to the complex and subtle ways that past mistakes, arrogance, misuse of authority and sinfulness have damaged our social fabric in ways we have barely begun to redress.

We ask you to open our hearts that we may continue to listen even when the truth challenges us; that we may understand that we are heirs to a system that has shown itself capable of domination and cruelty, whether or not we personally contributed; that we may commit ourselves in all humility to do what we can and support the efforts of others to restore our ruptured social fabric. Amen.

Let us pray for the children who died in residential schools throughout Canada and for all those impacted by this tragedy, that there may be healing founded on truth and that the Spirit will inspire our ongoing commitment to reconciliation. We pray to the Lord.

#### A PRAYER TO THE BLESSED VIRGIN OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL: JULY 16

On **Friday**, **July 16th** is the Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Please join us at the 12:00 Noon daily Mass as we celebrate this feast day.

It is on this day in about 1386 that Our Lady appeared to St. Simon Stock. She gave him a Brown Scapular saying, "Take, beloved son this scapular of thy order as a badge of my confraternity and for thee and all Carmelites a special sign of grace; whoever dies in this garment, will not suffer everlasting fire."

The scapular symbolizes Mary's protection and reminds those wearing it of the call to prayer and penance. It stands for a commitment to follow Jesus and imitate Mary as the perfect model of all disciples of Christ.

**NOTE:** For those parishioners who would like to have their vehicles blessed after the daily Mass are asked to contact the Parish office. After the blessing, Fr. Carlos will be giving out one scapular per vehicle.
