

6 BENEFITS OF EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

1. Every Holy Hour we make so pleases the Heart of Jesus that it is recorded in Heaven and retold for all eternity! (*St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta*)

2. The spiritual lives of our families are strengthened through our Holy Hour. (*St. John Paul II*)

3. A Holy Hour of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament is so important to Jesus that a multitude of souls go to Heaven who otherwise would have gone to hell. *(Jesus revelation to Blessed Dina Belanger)*

STEWARDSHIP SUNDAY: SEPTEMBER 19

On Sunday, September 19th, on the 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Churches across the Archdiocese of Toronto will be celebrating Stewardship Sunday.

The Spirituality of Deep Stewardship: The term "stewardship" is often taken to be a code word for "tithing" or for "fundraising for religious purposes." Certainly, if we have a proper spirit of gratitude for all that we have received from God, and are resolved to act as responsible trustees of God's gifts (and that is, in fact, the real meaning of stewardship), then we will be disposed to contribute financially as members of our Church community, and this might involve tithing, or participating in raising funds.

Even when the Church was young, St. Paul was greatly concerned about organizing a collection (see I Corinthians 16:1-4; II Corinthians 8-9; Galatians 2:10; Romans 15:25-28). We do not live in a dream world, and so the work of the Church must be effectively funded. We must pay the bills, and care for the practical needs of the poor. That, however, is only one aspect of stewardship, and will take care of itself if the more profound aspects (stewardship of time and talent) are emphasized.
