

CANADIAN MISSIONS COLLECTION

THE POWER OF EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

Following is another excerpt taken from the book "In Sinu Jesu, When the Heart Speaks to Heart. The Journal of a Priest at Prayer, by a Benedictine Monk" (Angelico Press) which describes the power of Eucharistic Adoration.

"Come to Me in the Sacrament of My love, and enter there into the mystery of My oblation. I am not inactive, nor am I present after the manner of a thing that has in itself no life, no movement, no breath. I am present in all the glory of My humanity and in all the power of My divinity; just as I am present in heaven, so am I present in the tabernacles of My Church on earth.1 In heaven, My glory is the bliss of all My saints; on earth, that same glory is veiled in the Most Holy Sacrament to be the bliss of My saints here below. My sacramental joy is the unfailing joy of the saints on earth. If there is, at times, so little evidence of joy among My people on earth, it is because they ignore My real presence and fail to seek Me out where I am to be found: in the Sacrament where I wait for sinners, to love them, to forgive them, to heal them, to hold conversation with them, and to nourish them even with My very self."

The account of the journey to Emmaus is one of accompaniment, recognition, and proclamation. The Risen Jesus walked with the two disciples, told them about Himself in the scriptures, and ate with them. "They said to each other, 'Were not our hearts burning within us while he was talking to us..." (Luke 24:32). After they encountered Jesus, they went back quickly to tell the good news of Jesus to the others.

The new Directory for Catechesis asks us to do the same. To go out as those who 'echo the faith', to engage with people of all ages and at all stages of life through our words and actions, giving witness to the Good News.
