ST. CYRIL & ST. METHODIUS

February 14th is the memorial of **St. Cyril** and **St. Methodius** who are sometimes referred to as the Apostles of the Slavs. These two brothers are known for devising the Glagolitic alphabet. Pope Leo XIII introduced their feast day into the Roman Catholic Church calendar in 1880 and in 1980 Pope John Paul II declared them co-patron saints of Europe.



O God, who enlightened the Slavic peoples through the brothers Saints Cyril and Methodius, grant that our hearts may grasp the words of your teaching, and perfect us as a people of one accord in true faith and right confession.


