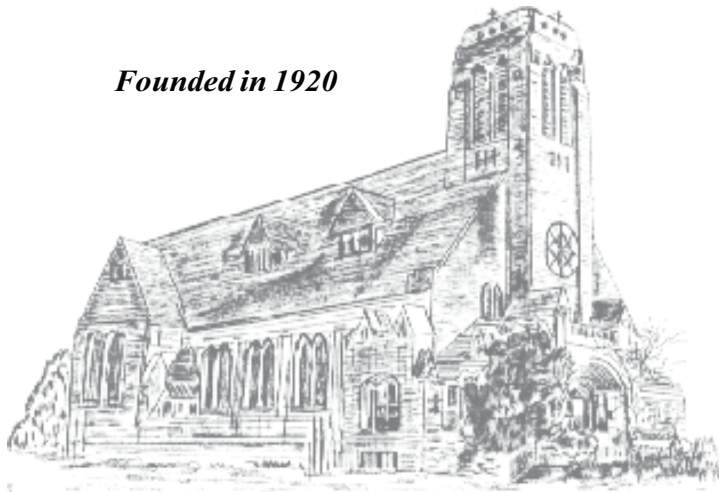

POPE FRANCIS' LENTEN MESSAGE: SOW SEEDS OF GOODNESS

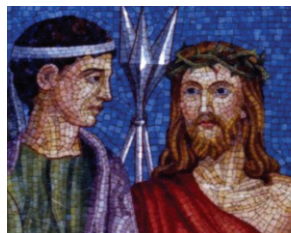


In his message for Lent 2022, Pope Francis invites the faithful to sow seeds of goodness, so that we might reap a harvest of salvation for ourselves and others.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS MARCH 4th – APRIL 15th

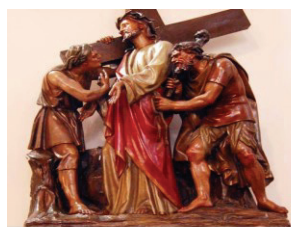
During these 7 weeks of Lent, each week, we will dedicate 2 stations of the cross for your reflection.

May 1 celebrates St. Joseph the Worker, patron of workers throughout the world

Where does the tradition of St. Joseph's Table come from?
According to legend, a famine struck Sicily centuries ago. Residents prayed to St. Joseph and asked for his intercession. Their prayers were answered. When the famine ended, a special feast of thanksgiving was held in honour of St. Joseph. This celebration became tradition. Wealthy families made preparations and invited the less fortunate over to share in a meal.

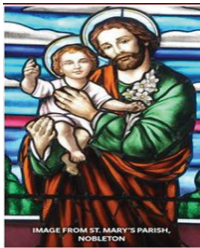
VIA CRUCIS
