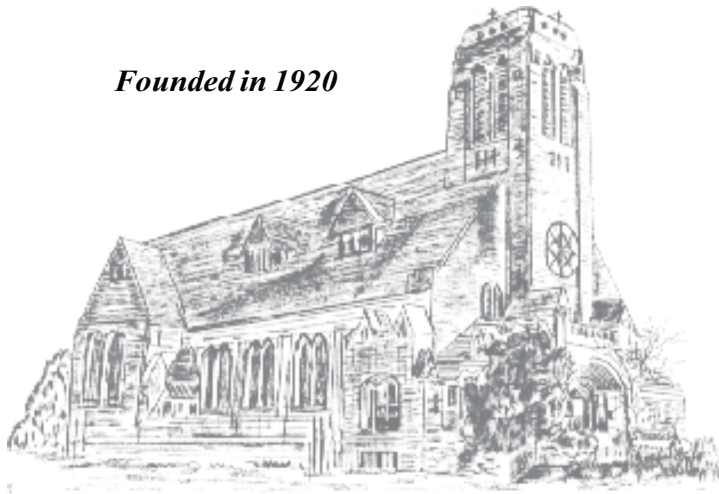

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Today's Gospel reminds us that there is one thing we must never lose sight of: Being with Jesus, in silence and prayerful adoration is the most important thing we can do. This doesn't undermine any other tasks we have to complete each day, but it does reveal that we should never neglect that which is most important. By identifying Mary's choice to sit at His feet, Jesus reminds us all of the importance of simply being with Him. Reflect, today, upon the image of Mary sitting quietly at the feet of Jesus. Use this image as a symbolic invitation to do the same this day. Have you prayed yet today? Have you sat silently with our Lord? Have you tried to enter into a deep adoration of Him through prayer and meditation? Choose the "better part" this day and you will find that all else falls in place to a much better degree.
