SEASON OF CREATION 2022

Today is the **Second Sunday in the Season of Creation**. In today's Gospel from Luke 15, we have the parable of 2 brothers. One brother "squandered his property in

dissolute living" and we read that he is then faced with famine. During this Season of Creation, this text echoes the squandering of the earth's resources. Pope Francis tells us in Laudato Si' that the effects of the present imbalance can only be reduced by our decisive action, here and now. (LS, 161). Laudato Si' also tells us that "all is not lost." Like the younger son in the parable today we can 'come to our senses' turn around and make a new start. Each of us can do something, each of us has a role to play in order to bring healing to our common home.


