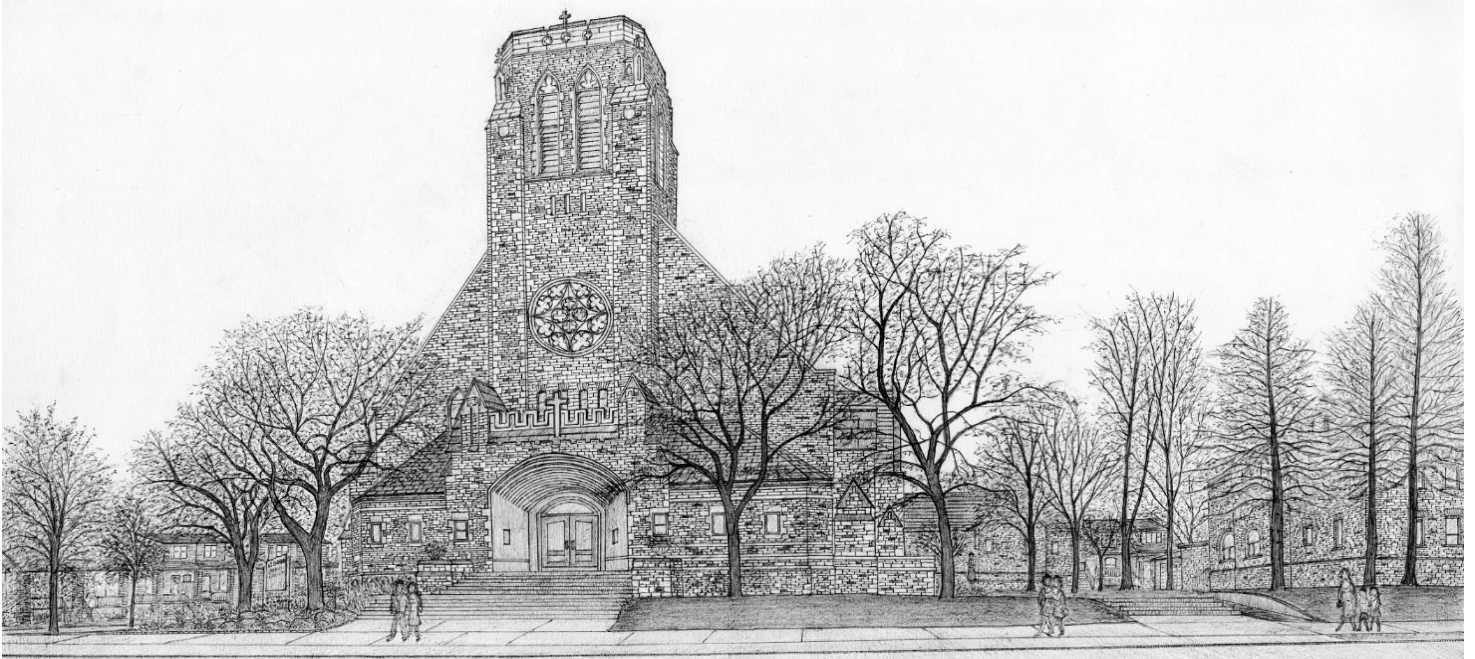

Reflections On Laudato Si’ - The Gospel of Creation

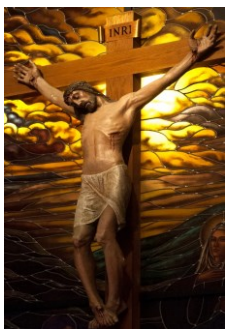
