SPONSORS & GODPARENTS

Here are the Church's rules regarding who can be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation:

- The individual must be a Roman Catholic who is baptized and confirmed.
- The person must be at least 16 years of age.
- The sponsor may be male or female. At baptism, if there are two sponsors, there must be one male and one female, never two of the same gender.
- Parents may not be sponsors for their own children.
- The sponsor should be a faithful, practicing Catholic who will serve as a good role model.
- If the sponsor is married, he/she must be validly married in the Roman Catholic Church.


