

The first Sunday of Advent marks the beginning of the liturgical year. As a Christian tradition, the wreath holds the four Advent candles. The candles represent Jesus coming as the light in darkness. One candle is lit each Sunday until all four candles are lit. As Christmas draws nearer, each candle brings a little more light into the darkness Each of the candles lit before Christmas represent an aspect of preparation during the season of Advent.

THE FIRST CANDLE REPRESENTS: HOPE

Purple is the primary color associated with Advent, it symbolizes penance, preparation, and sacrifice. During the first week of Advent, we remember the Old Testament prophets who foretold of Jesus' coming with hope and anticipation.
