Every month Pope Francis entrusts his Worldwide Prayer Network with prayer intentions that express his great concerns for humanity and for the mission of the Church. His monthly prayer intention is a global summons to transform our prayers into "concrete actions"; it is a compass for the mission. It summarizes his action plan to mobilize us each month, through prayer and action, for a proposition that invites us to build a more humane and caring world.

The Holy Father's Intentions for the month of January: Intention for evangelization - Human fraternity: May the Lord give us the grace to live in full fellowship with our brothers and sisters of other religions, praying for one another, open to all.

POPE FRANCIS PROCLAIMS THE UPCOMING YEAR TO BE DEDICATED TO THE FAMILY

From the Associated Press – Vatican News: The Pontiff offers simple advice to help bickering families keep peace. On Sunday, December 27th, Pope Francis proclaimed the upcoming year be dedicated to the family as he doubled down on one of his papal priorities and urged renewed attention to his 2016 document on family life.

Pope Francis announced the upcoming year of the family would begin on **March 19th**, the fifth anniversary of his document "The Joy of Love." Among other things, the document opened the door to letting divorced and civilly married couples to receive Communion, sparking criticism and even claims of heresy from conservative Catholics.

The Pope penned the document after summoning bishops from around the world to debate how the Catholic Church can better minister to families. While the divorce-remarriage issue dominated headlines during the back-to-back synods, the discussion also touched on ministering to gay people and other "non-traditional" families.

POPE FRANCIS PROCLAIMS "YEAR OF ST. JOSEPH"

From Vatican News: With the Apostolic Letter "Patris Corde" ("With a Father's Heart"), Pope Francis recalls the 150th anniversary of the declaration of Saint Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church. Pope Francis describes Saint Joseph as a beloved father, a tender and loving father, an obedient father, an accepting father; a father who is creatively courageous, a working father, a father in the shadows. To mark the occasion, the Holy Father has proclaimed a "Year of Saint Joseph" which started on December 8th, 2020 and will end on December 8th, 2021.

FRATELLI TUTTI - POPE FRANCIS' NEW ENCYCLICAL IS NOW AVAILABLE

Pope Francis' new encyclical titled "Fratelli Tutti" based on fraternity and social friendship is now available. In this encyclical, Pope Francis answers the questions - what are the great ideals and what are the tangible ways to advance for those who wish to build a more just and fraternal world in their ordinary relationships, in social life, politics and institutions?
